

2021 PRESIDENT'S CUP

Experimental format for 10m Air Rifle/10m Air Pistol Mixed Team events

The Mixed Teams will be formed by draw from among the top 12 Men and the top 12 Women (as per the ISSF World Ranking), irrespective of nationality

Qualification: according to the existing rules of Stage 1. Top eight MTs proceed to the Semifinal.

Semifinal: 2 groups of 4 MTs. Group 1 – places 1, 3, 5 and 7 after Qualification. Group 2 – places 2, 4, 6 and 8 after Qualification.

Scoring: on points

4 MTs start from “zero” and make five single shots. Each shot can bring any MT 4 points (best combined result of two athletes), 3 points (second combined result), 2 points (third combined result) or 1 point (lowest combined result). Same result brings the same number of points.

After 5 single shots the MT with the lowest number of points is eliminated. In case of the same result for the fourth place, shoot-off must take place.

Three MTs continue with the next series of 5 single shots. Each shot can bring any MT 3 points (best combined result of two athletes), 2 points (second combined result) or 1 point (lowest combined result). Same combined result brings the same number of points.

After the second series of 5 shots another MT with the lowest number of points is eliminated. In case of the same result for the third place, shoot-off must take place.

Two MTs continue with another series of 5 single shots. Each shot can bring any MT 2 points. The MT with lower result gets 0 points. In case of the same result of the shot – each MT gets 1 point.

The MT with the biggest number of points after 15 shots becomes the winner and proceeds to the Medal Match. In case of the same number of points, shoot-off must take place.

The MTs that win the second place in each Semifinal receive the bronze medal.

Final: Gold Medal Match according to the existing rules. The winning MT must get 16 points. The winners get the gold medals, the second placed MT – silver medals.
