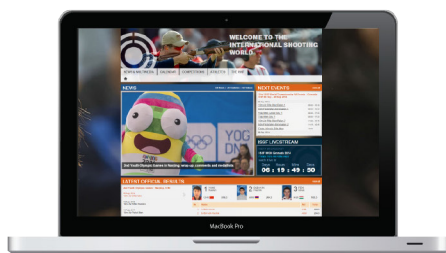

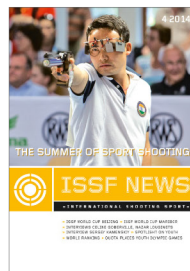

## 2. THE INTERNATIONAL SHOOTING SPORT FEDERATION

### WHO IS THE ISSF?

The International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) is the governing body of the Olympic Shooting events in Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun disciplines, and of several non-Olympic Shooting sport events. ISSF's activities include regulation of the sport, Olympic qualification and organization of international competitions such as the ISSF World Cup Series, the ISSF World Cup Final, the ISSF Separate World Championship in Shotgun events and the ISSF World Championship in all events.

Founded in 1907 as the International Shooting Union, and then changing its name in 1998, the ISSF affiliates nowadays more than 150 National Shooting Federations from Africa, Americas, Asia, Europe and Oceania. Since 1980, the ISSF Presidency is held by Mr. Olegario Vazquez Raña, a successful entrepreneur and a member of Mexico's shooting team at all Olympic Games from 1964 to 1976 and all World Championships from 1966 to 1979. The ISSF headquarter is based in Munich (GER).

The ISSF World Championship in Granada, Spain, is the 51st World Championship of our Federation's history, the previous being held in Munich (GER) in 2010, and the next scheduled to take place in Changwon (KOR) in 2018. For the first time in an ISSF World Championship in all events, the new ISSF Rules introduced after the 2012 Olympic Games will be in use. Major changes include Olympic-event finals starting from zero (the qualification score is not carried forward after the qualification), elimination-style finals, Semifinal and Medal Matches. The ISSF World Championship in Granada is also the first Shooting sport Olympic qualifier on the road to Rio 2016. A total of 64 Olympic Quota Places will be distributed through the 15 Olympic events during the World Championship.

### THE ISSF MILESTONES

**19TH CENTURY** – During the 19th century, earlier forms of organizations such as shooting clubs developed into national shooting federations. The Société Suisse des Carabiniers was founded in 1824 in Switzerland, the British National Rifle Association was inaugurated by Queen Victoria in 1859. Duke Ernst II of Saxony-Coburg and Gotha founded the Deutscher Schützenbund in 1861, and military leaders established the National Rifle Association of America (USA) in 1871.

The Federation Francaise des Societies de Tir was formally established in 1884, but earlier French national federations had preceded it.

**1896** – The shooting sport began part of the modern Olympic Family since its first steps. In the first Olympic Games, held in Athens in 1896, 39 athletes from seven nations competed in three pistol and two high-power rifle events. Shooting also was included in the program of the second Olympic Games where 139 athletes from 13 nations competed in three pistol, five rifle, two clay target and one running target events.

**1907** – On 17 July 1907, representatives of seven national shooting federations, six from Europe (Austria, Belgium, France, Greece, Italy, Holland) and one from South America (Argentina), met in Zurich, Switzerland, to formally establish the L'Union Internationale des Fédérations et Associations nationales de Tir (International Union of National Shooting Federations and Associations). Daniel

Mérillon, a 55-year old lawyer from Paris, was elected as the first ISSF President

**1912** – 284 athletes, coming from 16 different countries, participated in the 1912 Olympic Games of Stockholm, Sweden, in 15 total events, two pistol, eight rifle, two shotgun and three running target.

**1916** – The 1st World War in Europe caused the cancellation of the 1916 Olympic Games which were to take place in Berlin. The ISSF was dissolved, and L'Union des Sociétés de Tir de France was entrusted with the care of the ISSF records and property.

**1920** – President Mérillon re-establish the ISSF under the name L'Union Internationale de Tir (UIT). Mérillon was reelected President of the Union.

**1920** – The 1920 Olympics of Antwerp saw 21 shooting events in its program, the highest number of events in Olympic history. 18 nations participated with 233 athletes.

**1924** – The shooting events of the Paris Olympiad used ISSF regulations and were organized by L'Union des Sociétés de Tir de France. Over 260 athletes from 27 nations participated in the Olympic shooting events.

**1937** – The year 1937 saw the first participation of a Woman in an open World Championship event. Catherine Woodring fired as a member of the USA team, winning the 50-meter rifle prone gold team medal.



**1940** – Olympic Games of Helsinki could not take place: the second World War was exploded. For the second time in the ISSF's short history, a decision was made to suspend operations. The ISSF records and archives were transported by Karl August Larsson, Secretary General of the Swedish shooting federation, from Paris to Stockholm, where they could be protected in a neutral nation.

**1951** – The Pan American Games and Asian Games were both created as multi-sport international competitions like the Olympic Games, on their respective continents in 1951. Shooting was accepted as a sport in both.

**1958** – Men's Skeet event was added at the ISSF program

**1966** – The ISSF recognized all of its open events as "mixed" events where women could participate with men in 1966. The IOC also agreed to apply this standard to Olympic shooting events. For four Olympiads, from 1968 through 1980, the Olympic shooting events were mixed, with opportunities for women and men to participate regardless of gender.

**1966** – Air Rifle event was added at the ISSF program

**1970** – Air Pistol event was added at the ISSF program

**1978** – In 1978, the ISSF General Assembly elected several new Administrative Council members including Olegario Vazquez Raña, President of the Mexican Shooting Federation

**1980** – During the ISSF General Assembly of the XXII Olympiad that was held at Mexico City in 1980, Olegario Vazquez Raña emerged as the leading candidate to be the next ISSF President. Vazquez Raña was an active, successful athlete who competed for Mexico in four Olympic Games (1964, 1968, 1972, 1976) and five World Shooting Championships (1966, 1970, 1974, 1978, 1979). When the day to elect a new ISSF President came in February 1980, Olegario Vazquez Raña was elected as the sixth ISSF President with 125 of the 132 votes present at the Assembly. The 1980 General Assembly also elected a new Secretary General, Dr. Horst Schreiber, a prominent attorney in Munich, Germany who had successfully served in leadership roles in the sports of shooting, golf and tennis.

**1980** – The new leadership promoted a new ISSF Constitution that was drafted and approved by an Extraordinary General Assembly that met in Moscow in 1980.

**1980** – The General Assembly established the ISSF Women's Committee, that took the place of the 1977's provisional Ladies Committee.

**1984** – Ms. Unni Nicolaysen, the Secretary General of the Norwegian shooting federation, became the first woman in the 77-year history of the Federation to be elected to membership on the Administrative Council, a body with real decision-making power.

**1984** – The IOC agreed to add three women's events, 10 meter air rifle, 50 meter smallbore rifle 3x20, and 25 meter sport pistol, to the 1984 Olympic Games program.

**1986** – Following the invitation of the IOC, the ISSF develop an Olympic qualification system. The ISSF established a new series of World Cups, included them in the Olympic qualifying system, and recognize scores fired in World Cups as World Records. The first ISSF World Cup Rifle and Pistol was held in Mexico city, followed by the first ISSF World Cup Shotgun set in Montecatini, Italy, in April 1986.

**1988** – 10 meter Air Pistol Women Event was added to the 1988 Olympic program of the Seoul Games.

**1993** – The ISSF established the Training Academy in 1993. The Academy has now trained more than 400 shooting coaches from 74 different national federations.

**1996** – A shotgun event, double trap women, was added to the 1996 Olympic Games program.

**2000** – Following the introduction of the double trap women event at the previous Games of Atlanta, two additional women's shotgun events, trap and skeet, were added to the program of Sydney 2000.

**2004** – The Olympic Games of Athens saw a record participation of 106 countries, presenting 390 athletes to compete in 17 events.

**2004** – After the 2004 Olympics, women's double trap and 10 meters running target were discontinued as the overall Olympic shooting program was reduced from 17 to 15 events.

**2006** – The World Championship held in Zagreb, Croatia, in 2006, saw a record of participations: 1996 athletes from 97 countries were hosted in Zagreb. With the junior events, there were 54 individual and 51 team events.

**2006** – The 2006 ISSF General Assembly voted and re-elected President Olegario Vazquez Raña and Secretary General Horst G. Schreiber.

**2007** – One century after that first meeting in Zurich, today, the 17th of July 2007, ISSF celebrated his 100 years anniversary.

**2008** – The Olympic Games of Beijing saw the participation of 103 countries, presenting 390 athletes to compete in 15 events (9 men and 6 women), in the disciplines of Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun. Following what the IOC President Jacques Rogge called „a tradition“, the first Gold medal of the XXIX Olympiad was assigned to the Shooting sport. On April the 9th, Czech's Katerina Emmons became the first Olympic Gold medallist of the Olympic Games of Beijing 2008 by winning the 10m Air Rifle Women event.

**2010** – The 50th ISSF World Championship in all events is taking place in Munich, Germany, at the 1972 Olympic Shooting Range. A record number of 2400 athletes for a total of over 4000 starts were marked by the 50th ISSF World Championship, the largest ISSF Championship ever. Niccolò Campriani (ITA) wins the 10m Air Rifle Men event becoming the first qualified athlete for the London 2012 Olympic Games of the world, among all sport disciplines.

**2010** – Shooting sport is part of the program of the 1st Youth Olympic Games, held in Singapore. 80 young athletes participate in four shooting events (10m Air Pistol and Air Rifle, Men and Women).

**2012** – Fifteen Shooting events are conducted at the XXX Olympic Games, held in London. 390 athletes coming from 108 nations compete at the Royal Artillery Barracks Olympic venue, from the 28th of July through the 6th of August. Following a long lasting tradition, Shooting assigned the very first Gold medal of the Olympics at the 10m Air Rifle Women finals, won by Yi Siling of the People's Republic of China.

**2013** – ISSF Rules are updated, changing the face of the Olympic event finals. Major changes include finals starting from zero (the qualification score is not carried forward after the qualification), elimination-style finals, Semifinal and Medal Matches.

**2014** – Six Shooting events are staged at the 2nd Youth Olympic Games in Nanjing (CHN). Two new events, the 10m Air Pistol and Air Rifle Mixed International Teams, are added to the program as the IOC approved a request of the ISSF.

**2014** – The 51st ISSF World Championship is held in Granada, Spain. Junior finals are scheduled for the first time. 64 Olympic Quota Places for Rio 2016 will be distributed.



### 3. THE ISSF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

The ISSF World Championships in all events is the major competition organized under the ISSF flag. Being held every four years (two years after each Olympic Games), it attracts more than 2000 athletes from about 100 countries.

The first Shooting World Championship took place in 1897 in Lyon (FRA), where only one rifle event was staged. Nowadays, 117 years later, the program of the 51st ISSF World Championship in Granada includes 15 Olympic events and over 30 non-Olympic shooting events in the disciplines of Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun and Running Target, for Seniors (open category) and Juniors.

This 51st edition of the ISSF World Championship will stand as a milestone of our sport. Indeed, this is the first World Championship to be conducted under the new ISSF Rules introduced after the 2012 Olympic Games. Major changes include Olympic event finals starting from zero (Qualification scores are not carried forward anymore), the introduction of elimination-style finals, of Semifinals and Medal Matches. And, for the first time, Finals will be staged for selected competitions in the junior category.

This ISSF World Championship is also a fundamental step on the road leading to the Olympic Games: this is indeed the first qualification event for the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro. A total of 64 Olympic Quota Places will be distributed here in Granada in the next days.

The competition is announced to be spectacular: the best athletes of the world are here. The title defenders of the 2010 ISSF World Championship will meet the London 2012 Olympic Champions, the best ISSF World Cup scorers, as well as the recently awarded Youth Olympic Games champions. Over 2000 athletes, 100 countries, more than 50 competitions, and one dream: to become the new World Champion.

### THE LAST 11 ISSF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS IN ALL EVENTS

Edition	Year	Location	Did you know?
40th	1970	Phoenix, USA	New events were added to the World Championship program, increasing women's participation. For the first time, women's air rifle, sport pistol, standard pistol and air pistol events were conducted. Air Pistol men was also a new entry, in this edition.
41st	1974	Thun, SUI	Clay target events were organized in a different venue, in the city of Berne. Women's standard pistol event was cancelled that year.
42nd	1978	Seoul, KOR	Times were changing, and the men's standard rifle event was discontinued.
43rd	1982	Caracas, VEN	During this championship, hosted in the same venues of the 1954 ISSF WCH, electronic targets were used for the first time for 300m events. A 300m rifle prone event was added to the program.
44th	1986	Suhl, GDR	With no 300m ranges available in the German Democratic Republic in those days, 300m rifle events had to be hosted by the Swedish shooting federation in Skövde, Sweden.
45th	1990	Moskow, URS	The shooting sport came back on the venues of the 1980 Olympics. During that WCH, the Double Trap event was added to the program for the first time.
46th	1994	Milan, ITA	Milan's 1994 was a good example of "spread championship". Rifle and Pistol events took place in the city centre of Milan. 300m events were hosted in Tolmezzo, 300 km east of Milan, while clay target events took place in Fagnano, in the outskirts of the city.
47th	1998	Barcelona, ESP	King Juan Carlos I of Spain presided at the opening ceremony held in Barcelona. 300m rifle events were conducted in Zaragoza.
48th	2002	Lahti, FIN	A temporary range was erected in the Lahti Sports Stadium for the 25m and 50m events.
49th	2006	Zagreb, CRO	A record number of 1932 athletes participated 54 individual and 51 team events. Existing and temporary ranges in Zagreb and the immediate area hosted all events. The President of the Republic of Croatia, Stepan Mesic, presided at the opening ceremony.
50th	2010	Munich, GER	The ISSF World Championship breaks every record, this year, with about 2500 participating athletes. The IOC President, Dr. Jacques Rogge, presided at the opening ceremony.
51th	2014	Granada, ESP	The ISSF World Championship will be conducted under new ISSF Rules for Finals in Olympic events and for the first time Finals for Junior categories are organized.

## 4. OLYMPIC QUOTA PLACES

The 51st ISSF World Championship is the first Shooting sport qualification event for the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro (BRA).

Following the Olympic qualification path agreed with the International Olympic Committee, the first 64 Olympic Quota Places (out of a total of 390 Quotas) will be distributed here in Granada.

### QUOTA PLACES

What is a Quota Place or, as athletes often call them “Quotas” or “Olympic Tickets”? Since 1988, the Olympic Qualification System of the Shooting Sport is based on two fundamentals: the Olympic Quota Places, and the Minimum Qualification Scores (MQS).

Each athlete, to be eligible to take part in the Olympic Games or in the Youth Olympic Games, needs an Olympic Quota Place, and must have obtained a Minimum Qualification Score at least once during his/her shooting career.

A Quota Place is a qualification slot to enter the Olympic Games, awarded by the ISSF to those athletes who reach the best results during designated ISSF Olympic qualifier competitions such as the 51st ISSF World Championships in Granada, the 2015 ISSF World Cup Series and other designated Continental Championships.

“Quota Places” are country-related: the athlete wins a quota place for his/her country, which then decide how to use that qualification slot. Therefore, the athlete who secures a Quota is not automatically qualified for the Games, as the finals decision on the composition of the Olympic team is to be taken by his/her national team.

The International Olympic Committee assigned 390 Quota Places to the Shooting sport for the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio. Out of these 390 Qualification slots, 64 will be distributed in Granada.

That means that in each of the 15 Olympic Shooting events that will be conducted during the World Championship, the best finalists will be awarded an Olympic Quota Place. The first, second, third, 4, 5 or 6, ranked athletes - depending on the event - will secure a Quota (see the table for details).

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATION SCORE (MQS):

The MQS (Minimum Qualification Score) is a minimum score that an athlete must have recorded at least once during his/her shooting career, in order to become eligible to take part in the Olympic Games or in the Youth Olympic Games. The Minimum Qualification Scores for each shooting event are designated by the ISSF. The personal MQS scores of each athlete are recorded through ISSF supervised shooting events, and each athlete willing to participate in the Olympic Games or in the Youth Olympic Games must record it before heading to the Games. ## 5. OLYMPIC EVENTS PREVIEW

### THE ISSF OLYMPIC RIFLE EVENTS:

**10m Air Rifle Men, 10m Air Rifle Women, 50m Rifle 3 Positions Men, 50m Rifle 3 Positions Women, 50m Rifle Prone Men.**

For 10m Air Rifle events, athletes use air rifles loaded with .177 (4.5mm) caliber pellets. For 50m Rifle events, athletes use rifles loaded with .22 caliber (5.6mm) cartridges.

Athletes wear special shooting equipment such as jackets, trousers, gloves and shoes. These equipments are regulated and checked by the ISSF.

### RIFLE EVENTS FINALS FORMAT

According to the ISSF Rule changes introduced after the 2012 Olympic Games, all Olympic Rifle finals are conducted according to an elimination-style format. The top 8 athletes after the qualification advance to the finals. Finals start from zero: the qualification score is no longer carried forward into the finals. After a defined number of shots, the lowest-ranked athlete is eliminated and has to leave the finals, until the medalists are decided.

## 10M AIR RIFLE MEN

**Qualification** 60 shots  
**Finals** 20 shots  
**Finals – first elimination** First athlete eliminated after shot #8  
**10 ring diameter:** 0.5 mm

The 10m Air Rifle Men event is conducted in the standing position, using an air rifle loaded with .177 caliber (4.5mm) pellets. The target is placed at a distance of 10 meters and athletes reload after each shot (rifles are single-loaded).

The Qualification consist of 60 shots.

The elimination-style finals consists of a maximum of 20 shots. Qualification scores are not carried forward: the finals starts from zero and the individual scores are added together to build up the finals result.

After the athletes' presentation, the finals begins with two series of three shots (each series must be fired within 150 seconds). After the first two series, a total of 14 single shots are fired (each shot must be fired within 50 seconds), and after every 2 shots the lowest-ranked athlete is eliminated. The finals ends up with only two athletes left on the line, and the last 2 shots decide the Gold medal winner.

Ties are broken by shoot-offs.

The finals ends up with only two athletes left on the line, and the last two shots decide the Gold medal winner.

Ties are broken by shoot-offs.

The standing position starts with 2 series of 5 shots each (to be completed within 250 seconds per series) after which, the two lowest-ranked athletes are eliminated. The standing position then continues with 5 single shots (to be fired within 50 seconds per shot). The lowest-ranking athlete is eliminated after each single shot.

The finals ends up with only two athletes left on the line, and the last shot decides the Gold medal winner.

## THE ISSF OLYMPIC PISTOL EVENTS:

**10m Air Pistol Men, 10m Air Pistol Women, 50m Pistol Men, 25m Rapid Fire Pistol Men, 25m Pistol Women.**

For 10m Air Pistol events, athletes use air pistols loaded with .177 caliber (4.5mm) pellets. For 25m and 50m Pistol events, athletes use pistol loaded with .22 caliber (5.6mm) cartridges.

### PISTOL EVENTS FINALS FORMAT

According to the ISSF Rule changes introduced after the 2012 Olympic Games, 10m and 50m Pistol finals as well as the 25m Rapid Fire Pistol Men finals are conducted according to an elimination-style format. 25m Pistol Women finals are conducted over two phases: the Semifinals and the Medal Matches. All Pistol finals start from zero: the qualification score is no longer carried forward into the finals.

For 10m and 50m Pistol events, the top 8 athletes after the qualification advance to the finals. After a defined number of finals shots, the lowest-ranked athlete is eliminated and has to leave the match, until the medalists are decided.

For the 25m Rapid Fire Pistol Men event, the top 6 athletes after the qualification advance to the finals. Eliminations begin after the fourth series and continue after each series right to the eighth and last series, when the medals are decided.

For the 25m Pistol Women event, the top 8 athletes after the qualification advance to the semi-finals. The top 2 athletes of the semi-finals advance to the Gold medal match. The third and fourth ranked athletes after the semi-finals advance to the Bronze medal match.

The top 6 athletes after the Qualification advance to the elimination-style Finals. Qualification scores are not carried forward into the Finals: the finalists start from zero. The scoring system used during Finals is "hit or miss": a shot of 9.7 points or more counts as a "hit". A shot lower than 9.7 points counts as a "miss".

The Finals consists of 8 series (5 shots per series), with hit or miss scoring. Each series must be fired in 4 seconds: that means that the athletes have less than 1 second per each shot.

From the 4th series, and then after every series, the athlete with the lowest score is eliminated and has to leave the match. Eliminations continue until the 8th series, when the Gold and the Silver medals are decided.

In the rapid-fire stage six series of five shots must be completed in three seconds for each shot with a seven seconds break in between.

The 25m Pistol Women Finals consists of two Stages: a Semifinal and two Medal Matches, conducted in the standing position using a pistol loaded with five .22" caliber (5.6mm) cartridges in the magazine. The target is placed at a distance of 25 meters.

The top 8 athletes after the qualification advance to the Semifinal, which consists of 5 series of 5 shots each. Qualification scores are not carried forward into the Semifinal: all athletes start from zero.

Athletes only have 3 seconds to fire each shot, and they must lower their arm down at a 45° angle before firing each shot.

The top 2 athletes after the Semifinal advance to the Gold Medal Match. The 3rd and 4th ranked athletes after the Semifinal advance to the Bronze Medal Match.

The scoring system changes during the Medal Matches, from counting "hits" to "points". Each Medal Match is fired on a series-by-series basis. The athlete with the highest number of hits in each series receives 2 points. The first athlete who reaches the score of 7 points wins the match. In case of a tie in a series, 1 point each is awarded to both athletes.

If both athletes score 7 points in the same series, they will fire additional series until the tie is broken.

## 10M AIR PISTOL WOMEN

**Qualification** 40 shots  
**Finals** 20 shots  
**Finals – first elimination** First athlete eliminated after shot #8  
**10 ring diameter:** 11.5 mm

The 10m Air Pistol Women event is conducted in the standing position, using an air pistol loaded with .177 caliber (4.5mm) pellets. The target is placed at a distance of 10 meters and athletes reload after each shot (pistols are single-loaded).

The Qualification consist of 40 shots.

The elimination-style finals consists of a maximum of 20 shots. Qualification scores are not carried forward: the finals starts from zero and the individual scores are added together to build up the finals result.

After the athletes' presentation, the finals begins with two series of three shots (each series must be fired within 150 seconds). After the first two series, a total of 14 single shots are fired (each shot must be fired within 50 seconds), and after every 2 shots the lowest-ranked athlete is eliminated. The finals ends up with only two athletes left on the line, and the last 2 shots decide the Gold medal winner.

Ties are broken by shoot-offs.

## THE ISSF OLYMPIC SHOTGUN EVENTS:

### Trap Men, Trap Women, Double Trap Men, Skeet Men, Skeet Women.

Athletes use a 12-gauged, single trigger, over-under shotgun. The shotgun is loaded with smooth bored shells with a maximum of 24.5 grams of pellets.

Targets used in ISSF competitions measure about 11cm (4 inches) in diameter and about 2,5cm (1 inch) in height. Targets used in Semifinal and Medal Matches might also contain an orange or green powder that puffs when the target is hit (so called flash targets).

Targets are thrown by special throwing machines installed in a bunker placed 15 meters in front of the athlete (Trap and Double Trap events) or inside two houses placed at the left and right sides of the range (Skeet events).

### SHOTGUN COMPETITION FORMAT

The top 6 athletes after the Qualification advance to the Finals. Finals consist of two Stages: the Semifinal and the Medal Matches.

According to the new ISSF Rules introduced after the 2012 Olympic Games, all shotgun finals start from zero. That means that the Qualification and the Semifinal scores are not carried forward into the following competition phases.

The top 2 athletes after the Semifinal advance to the Gold Medal Match; the third and fourth placed athletes compete in the Bronze Medal Match.

### TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

Ties after the Qualification, or involving 2nd or 4th place at the end of a Semifinal, or ties at the end of the Medal Matches, are broken by shoot-offs (the first who misses is out).

During a medal match, the two athletes compete on stations 2, 3 and 4 only, shooting a total of 30 targets (15 doubles). Ties at the end of a medal match are decided by shoot-offs.

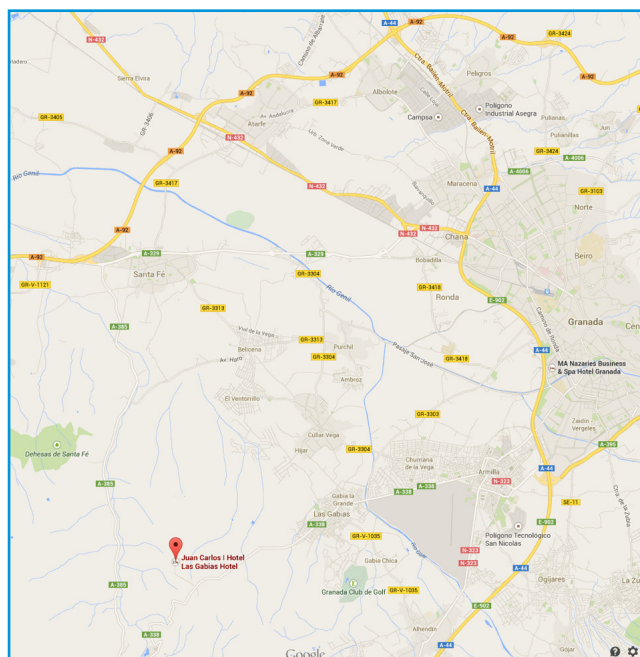
### THE VENUE

The 51st ISSF World Championship will take place at the Cear Juan Carlos I sport complex. The venue was built in 2002 and lies on a 250.000 m2 area in the municipality of Las Gabias, in the outskirts of Granada.
