Internal ISSF Indemnity Rules

(approved by the ISSF Executive Committee on March 22nd, 2019)

Preface

The ISSF emphasises the importance of good governance also enshrined in the Olympic Agenda 2020. Among the Basic Principles of Good Governance for Sports Organisations, transparency is one of the most important.

Therefore, the ISSF Executive Committee decided to establish the Internal ISSF Indemnity Rules. These rules are in line with the legal status of the ISSF as a non-profit organisation and the whole spirit of promoting the shooting sport.

The Rules also take in consideration the provisions of the Guidelines to article 1.5.3 of the ISSF Constitution and that the members of the ISSF elected Bodies are volunteers.

Indemnities

The personal administrative expenses related to the execution of the respective functions within the ISSF will be compensated with the below mentioned fixed amounts.

The indemnities are as follows:

For members of the Executive Committee attending the official meetings	EUR900
For members of the Administrative Council attending the official meetings	EUR700
For members of any other ISSF Committee attending the official meetings	EUR500

Payments will be made upon formal request and exclusively via bank transfer.

The ISSF will cover accommodation expenses if meetings last longer than three days. Additional travel and accommodation expenses will be covered by the ISSF in case the General Assembly, the Executive Committee or the President take the decision to hold a special meeting of an ISSF Body as well as in case the President requests a member of an ISSF Body or an official of the ISSF Member Federation for the purpose of a special mission.
