All ISSF Men's, Women's and Junior Mandatory events for Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun and Running Target are included in the program of the 50th ISSF World Championship.

In the Olympic events and categories Quota places for the London Olympic Games 2012 will be awarded.

A maximum number of 3 shooters per event per national federation will be entered into the World Championship. Teams are formed by 3 individuals of the same national federation competing in the same event and category.

4 **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The competition will be conducted according to the ISSF rules and regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

The equipment control according to the ISSF rules will be conducted.

All rifle shooters having an ISSF certificate for Rifle clothing are exempt at the equipment control section for those items of clothing on the ISSF Certificate.

It is the shooter's responsibility that any air or Co² cylinder has been certified as safe and is still within the validity date. If the validity date has expired the use of this cylinder is not allowed.

Due to environment Legislation Nickel-plated shot is not allowed on the shotgun ranges.

5 **ENTRY PROCESS**

Preliminary Entries (ISSF GR 3.7.3.1)

Each national federation entering the ISSF World Championship must submit a preliminary entry (Annex 1) not later than **December 29th, 2009**.

If the ISSF online registration is used the preliminary entries will be entered there otherwise they must be send to the Organizing Committee.

Final Entries

The member federations make their final entries (see specified Annexes 4.1, 4.2, 4.3) directly to the **ISSF Headquarters** through online registration, fax or email. The deadline is fixed on **June 29th, 2010**.

Late Entries

Late entries can only be allowed according to ISSF GR 3.7.3.4.
Any additional entries received after the Final Entry Deadline of three (3) days before the official arrival day may not participate (ISSF GR 3.7.3.5).

Cancellation

Any federation reducing the number of shooters and / or officials after the Official Entry Deadline is obligated to pay all applicable fees and costs including entry fees according to the number of shooters and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid no member of that federation may participate (ISSF GR 3.7.4.3).

7.2 GUN LICENSE

Owners of an European Firearms Passport may import their guns without an auxiliary permission to Germany. *You don't have to declare air guns and the proper ammunition at all, if they conform to the international standard.*

All national federations who do not belong to the European Union have to declare their guns and ammunition for small and big bore rifles and pistols.

**Please register online at: <http://entry.issf-sports.info>
Only the owners of online registered guns will receive the below mentioned general permission.**

After **online registration of** your guns you will receive a general permission from the district office of Munich. This exceptional rule is valid from July 8th to August 18th 2010. Upon entry to Germany participants must show a copy of this general disposition and the confirmation of participation by name from the Organising Committee.

All guns must be submitted at the first arrival on the shooting range to the Gun Inspection Department for inspection before storing in the armory to verify the conformity of the general permission with the imported guns. This check is for the gun legislation only and not for the approval of the guns according to the competition rules.

The charge for an approved guns and ammunition declaration is 20 Euro per federation.

It is recommended to all delegations to carry the list of all firearms and ammunition with themselves, to be presented to customs or border police upon request together with the invitation. During your stay in Germany/Munich **all guns and ammunition** must be stored in the armory on the shooting range (also air guns and ammunition).

8 CUSTOM FORMALITIES

All national federations without the European firearms passport have to be in possession of the **approved** gun importation form, certified by the German authorities. For those who arrive at the Munich airport, please make sure that you carry along a copy of your certified gun form.

The **original documents** will be **deposited at the customs** where **you must pick them up**, before leaving the customs area.

Please note: To import air guns without an auxiliary permission, they need to have the international embossing / stamping "F".

11 INFORMATION ON RANGE EQUIPMENT

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

- 10m hall 100 firing points, electronic targets, **SIUS**
- 50m range 100 firing points, electronic targets, **Polytronic**
- 25m range 40 firing points (8 boxes), electronic targets, **SIUS**
- 300m range 40 firing points, electronic targets, **SIUS**
- Running Target range 5 firing points, electronic targets, **SIUS**
- Final hall 10 firing points Rifle/Pistol, electronic targets, **SIUS**
- There are five combined ranges for Trap, Skeet and Double Trap which are equipped with **Matarelli** machines.

Clay Targets: **Matarelli, Vita** or **Laporte**, in the Finals **Flash Targets**.

Information and announcements will be found in the pigeon holes of the Nations.

Start lists and result lists will be found on the internet.

Furthermore there are several service stations on the shooting range where hardcopies of all start lists and result lists are available free of charge for shooters and officials. Those lists will not distributed to the pigeon holes.

12 AMMUNITION

Additional ammunition can be purchased at the range. Please order the needed ammunition in advance stating the quantity and brand. We will send a list of brands and prices as well as an order form in April 2010 to all participation federations.

13 GUNS STORAGE

It is not allowed to take any guns and ammunition out of the shooting range especially not to the hotel. The completeness will be checked every evening. The armory will be opened from **July 26th** till the day after the official departure day **August 12th**.

18 DOPING INFORMATION

The Organizing Committee will conduct doping controls according to the ISSF doping regulations.

19 CEREMONIES

The **Award Ceremonies** will take place on the Konrad-Wirnhier-Platz. The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations.

The **Opening Ceremony** is planned July 30th at 4.00 pm on the Marienplatz in Munich (downtown), bus-shuttle is available.

The **Closing Ceremony** is scheduled on August 10th after the award ceremony.

During the Award or other Ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms). All team members must be dressed in the same way.

ISSF DRESS CODE

A Rule Interpretation Regarding Shooter's Clothing

ISSF Rule 6.4.2.1. *It is the responsibility of the competitor to appear on the ranges dressed in a manner appropriate to a public event. This must be controlled by the Jury....*

All sports are concerned with the image they present to the public and media. Olympic sports, in particular, are judged by whether their competitors look like athletes and their officials appear professional. Shooting's ability to grow as a sport and its future status in the Olympic movement may be affected by how its athletes and officials appear to the public and media.

Recent evaluations made by ISSF leaders in cooperation with IOC and media officials have identified concerns regarding certain clothing worn by shooters during competitions and award ceremonies. Of special concern are blue jeans and ragged cut-off shorts worn by pistol and shotgun shooters during qualification and final round competitions. There have also been cases of clothing worn during award ceremonies that clearly does not represent the sport of shooting or the national federations, Olympic committees or nations of those athletes in a positive way.

CLOTHING REGULATIONS

In order to address this situation and achieve positive change, the ISSF Executive Committee provides the following guidelines regarding how Rule 6.4.2.1 will be interpreted and enforced, beginning in 2010:

1. All clothing worn by competitors in training, elimination, qualification and final round competitions and in award ceremonies must be clothing that is appropriate for wear by athletes in international-class competition. All clothing must convey positive images of shooting athletes as competitors in an Olympic sport.
2. During award or other ceremonies, athletes are required to be dressed in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms of training or warm-up uniforms including sport shoes). For teams, all members of the team must wear the same national uniforms. Rule 6.17.5.5.
3. Pistol competitors must comply with Pistol Clothing Regulations described in Rule 8.4.5.
4. Shotgun competitors must comply with Shotgun Clothing Regulations described in Rule 9.9.1.

5. Rifle competitors must wear shooting jackets and trousers that comply with Rifle Clothing Regulations described in Rule 7.4.6.
6. The intention of ISSF pistol and shotgun clothing rules is that shooters in competitions must wear sports-type clothing that incorporates or displays national, NOC or NF colors and emblems. Appropriate clothing for wear during competitions includes training suits, tracksuits or warm-up uniforms, etc. as issued by national federations or NOCs.
7. Prohibited clothing items for competitions and award ceremonies include blue jeans, jeans or similar trousers in non-sporting colors, camouflage clothing, sleeveless T-shirts, shorts that are too short, ragged cut-off shorts, all types of sandals, trousers with patches or holes as well as shirts or trousers with non-sporting or inappropriate messages (See Rule 6.10.1).
8. Changing clothing must be done in designated areas and not on the field of play.
9. All clothing must comply with ***ISSF Eligibility and Sponsorship Rules*** regarding the display of manufacturer and sponsor marks.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES

- ⊙ ISSF Equipment Control, Shotgun, Pistol and Rifle Juries are responsible for enforcing ISSF Clothing Regulations and this interpretation of ISSF Clothing Regulations.
- ⊙ During the 2010 World Cups, ISSF Juries will issue verbal warnings regarding violations. Juries will maintain a record of all warnings issued, noting the shooter's name, national federation and specific violation. ISSF Technical Delegates will forward this information to ISSF Headquarters. ISSF Headquarters will request National Federations with many athletes that receive warnings to assist in correcting these violations.
- ⊙ Beginning with the 2010 World Shooting Championship, ISSF Juries will issue written warnings with requests to correct clothing violations for first violations. Athletes who receive written warnings and who do not correct clothing violations (change clothing) will be disqualified. Juries will normally give warnings during equipment inspection or training. Juries may allow a competitor to complete a pre-event training series or stage (shotgun or 25m pistol) before changing if sufficient time to change is not available. No athlete will be permitted to participate in a qualification or final round competition while wearing inappropriate or prohibited clothing.

ISSF Statement Regarding Rifle Shooter Clothing

Draft minutes from the 2009 ISSF Technical and Rifle Committee meetings on 08/09 November 2009 were recently posted on the Internet without authorization. Unfortunately, this posting made no attempt to explain any of the reasons for these proposals. This premature and incomplete posting created confusion and led to much discussion among shooters, trainers and equipment manufacturers. The ISSF is releasing this statement to give everyone concerned a full explanation and explain actions that will be taken regarding rifle shooter clothing in 2010.

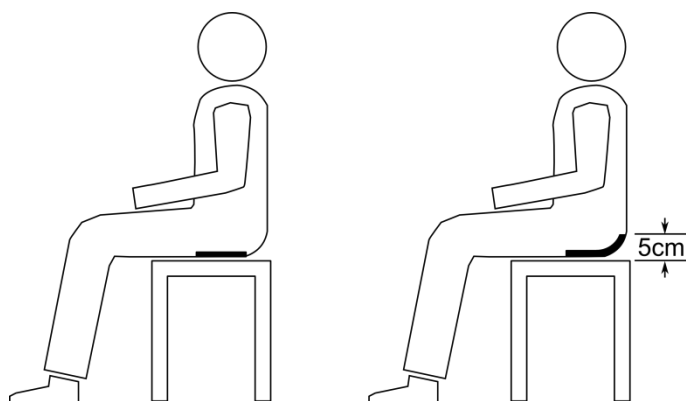
First, the minutes from the 2009 ISSF Technical and Rifle Committees meetings contain only discussion topics and recommendations. ISSF Rules do not change until the ISSF Administrative Council approves changes and nothing in those minutes has been approved. Second, those minutes contain preliminary proposals designed to address some serious rifle shooter clothing problems that developed in the last year. The ISSF Technical and Rifle Committees expressed their opinion that some recently introduced shooter clothing was made of materials that could violate current stiffness rules. When a new model of shooting trousers stand up by themselves and do not collapse even after substantial pressure is placed on them, there is reasonable cause to doubt that this equipment complies with the ISSF Rules and Regulations. When trouser seat pads become back supports, it is reasonable to issue new rule interpretations. When IOC members ask critical questions about why elite shooter-athletes cannot walk normally, their questions must be taken seriously. Stiffer clothing designed to provide increased support violates IOC rules prohibiting the artificial enhancement of athlete performance and ISSF rules prohibiting artificial support.

Continued efforts by manufacturers to produce rifle clothing that is less flexible than clothing currently approved and used by shooters can be similar to the "technological doping" that FINA (international swimming federation) fought last summer when it banned a whole series of new swimwear that had been worn by swimmers who totally rewrote their list of world records. The ISSF would be abandoning its responsibility to our sport and its athletes if we do not act to control similar developments in shooting.

The ISSF has worked hard since 2005 to control rifle clothing stiffness and flexibility through stricter and more consistent equipment control testing. The ISSF Athletes Commission and many athletes have applauded how this makes it possible for all shooters to have clothing that is relatively equal. The ISSF and its athletes surely do not want to return to the unfair situation that sometimes occurred before that date when inconsistent enforcement and artificial manipulation of jackets and trousers (heat, etc.) allowed some shooters to compete with clothing that provided more support than clothing used by shooters who complied fully with the rules.

As part of its continuing efforts to keep all rifle shooter clothing sufficiently flexible to comply with ISSF rules and equal for all competitors, the ISSF will follow this plan of action during 2010:

1. The most recent proposals of the ISSF Rifle and Technical Committees will be carefully studied and discussed by several groups within the ISSF before any final proposals are developed for presentation to the Administrative Council. The opinions of athletes, trainers and manufacturers will of course be considered.
2. ISSF Equipment Control Juries at 2010 World Cups and the 2010 World Championship will continue their strict enforcement of ISSF rules regarding clothing thickness, stiffness and flexibility. Specially trained experts in these control procedures will chair all 2010 Equipment Control Juries. Rule 6.6.3 gives ISSF Equipment Control Juries full authority to apply the flexibility standards of Rule 6.4.2.1.1 (must not ***immobilize or unduly reduce the movement of the shooter's legs, body or arms***) to determine whether all rifle clothing complies with the "spirit and intent" of that rule.
3. ISSF Rule 7.4.7.8.2.3 regarding the height of the seat patch reinforcement states, ***The seat patch...vertical measurement must not be longer than to cover the normal wear points on the seat of the wearer.*** Starting in 2010, ISSF Equipment Control Juries will interpret this rule to mean that "normal wear points" are determined when shooting trousers are fully closed and the shooter is sitting. This means that any pad or reinforcement placed directly below the waistband is illegal and must be removed.
4. There is a concern that rifle shooting boots are becoming stiffer and less flexible. As one way to check shooting boot flexibility, shooters may be asked by Equipment Control or Rifle Juries to walk normally with their jackets, trousers and boots on and fully closed or laced to demonstrate that their boots are flexible. "Walk normally" means the knees must bend, the heels must strike the floor first and then visibly rise from the floor before the toes are lifted.



5. A meeting of the **ISSF Special Commission on Rifle Shooter Clothing** will be organized in December 2010 to evaluate all aspects of rifle shooter clothing and prepare possible recommendations for future changes in ISSF rules or inspection procedures. This meeting will include members of the ISSF Executive Committee, Administrative Council and the Technical and Rifle Committees. Representatives of athletes, coaches and manufacturers will be invited to participate in this meeting.
